Monthly club President's report

The Nash Bill & Committee Appointment

Written submissions have been sent to the select committee (and read). Those of us that requested to speak to the committee on our submissions have spoken, this is still ongoing.

Bette Cosgrove has been invaluable to the club with research, social media posts, information, ideas, drafted letters, and much more. One of the letters we sent to all councils explained the effects of the Nash Bill (if passed) on their regions and campers in general. That letter included questions for councillors to consider relating to the council's management and increased costs of administering the Bill, again if passed.

As this is ongoing, we have appointed Bette to the APCNZ committee as an advisor on this issue. I would like to thank Bette for the huge amount of time and effort she has and is putting into this very important issue that will affect us all.

Update: The NZ Labour Party is now reviewing all planned policies for 2023. We have our fingers crossed.

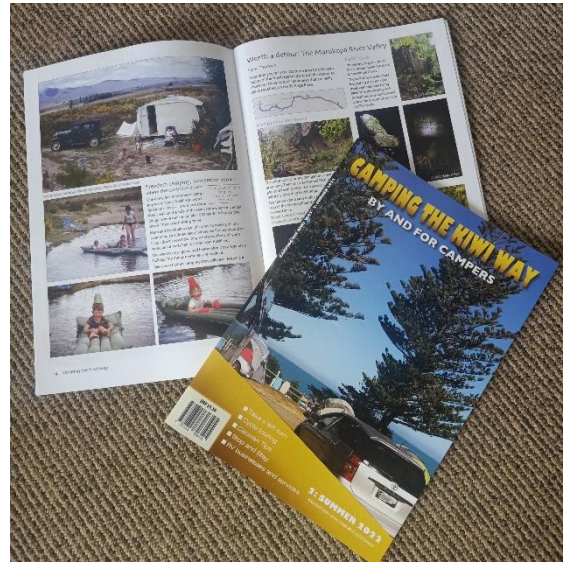

Regional Reps

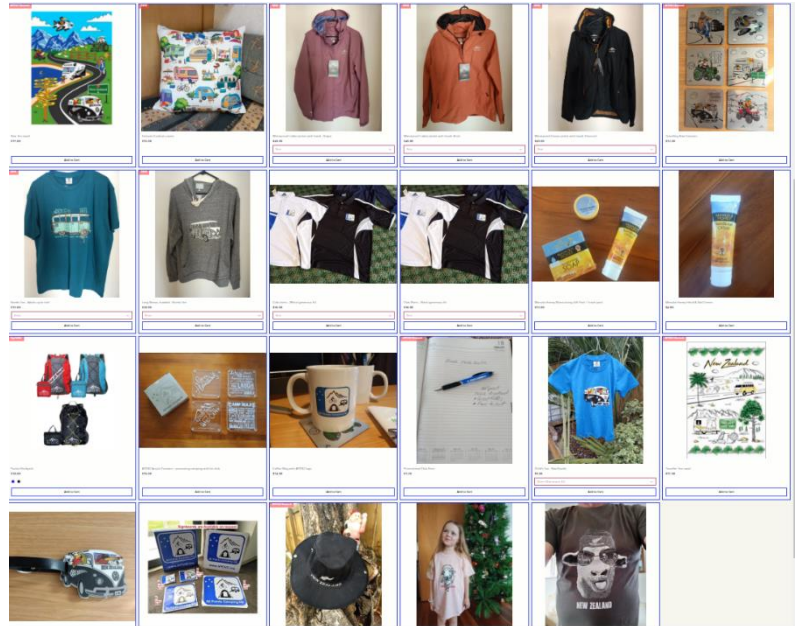
