- Explore the unique Bulls township or head down to the river for a swim.

Dates and times:

Friday 23 February 11:00 AM to Monday 27 midday. The gates will be shut at 9pm Friday. Due to considerable traffic issues it is recommended the vehicles do not leave or arrive the complex Saturday or Sunday

Venue:

Harrisville Speedway 65B Tangimoana Road (On the Palmerston North Side of the Bulls bridge, turn south opposite the big black bull). Look for the All Points Camping and Harrisville Speedway signs.

Price and payment options at the venue. EFTPOS or cash

Adults (16years+) \$13.00 per person per night

Children (up to 15 yrs) Free

- Eftpos will be available on the Friday evening between 5pm and 7pm.
- Cash payments can be made to the All Points Camping Team after arrival on the Friday.
- All cash payments will be receipted.

(Note: All Points Camping does not operate to make a profit and has contracted to pay Harrisville Speedway a rate \$12.00 per adult per night retaining \$1.00 towards overhead costs)

The venue:

Harrisville Speedway is a private Speedway facility which is used for summer meetings and regular practice sessions. The venue is continually being developed and also has a function room (saloon), large covered outdoor area and private memorabilia museum.

- Camping sites will be on the large, level, paddock area or within the Speedway circuit. There is also hard parking near the Saloon. Fresh 'cold' water is available throughout the weekend.
- Porta-loos are onsite for the weekend camp.
- The function room will be open Saturday night with music.
- Cooking - Bring your own BBQ's (Subject to numbers there may be a food / coffee cart onsite. TBC)
- Washing. A basic camp sink will be available for rinsing dishes / general washing.
- Each campsite will be given a rubbish bag on registration.
- There are no showers on site. Heat you own water / solar showers an option.

Our weekend camping suggestions and tips:

We will try to cover the essentials (e.g. toilet paper, rubbish bags) but suggest the following items to bring.

Water containers for carrying water.
Plastic basin / tub for washing with detergent
Chilly Bin with Ice or frozen products
Some bottled water
Disposal Plates.
Sunscreen and Hats
Hand sanitiser
Toilet paper
Wet wipes
Old newspaper for wrapping waste.

A couple of tips for food

- Longlife milk
- Coffee sachets
- Wraps stay fresher than bread
- Small cans of shredded chicken and salad fillings makes a great lunch
